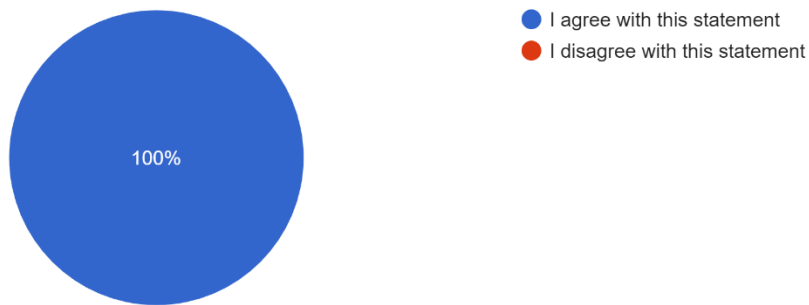

We aim to provide work that children can access at home with support from parents which focuses on key aspects of learning. We do not w...cation between members of our school community.

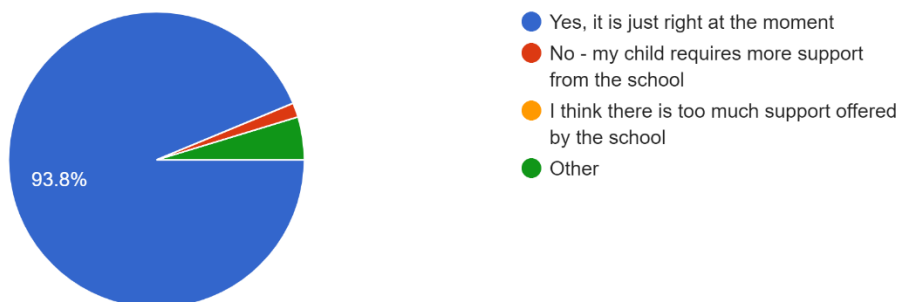

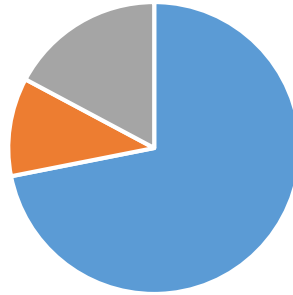

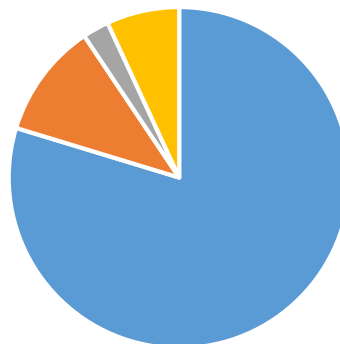


■ My child enjoys Google Meets 71.9% ■ My child does not enjoy Google Meets 10.9% ■ other 17.2%

■ We would prefer more 2.5% ■ Other 6.9%

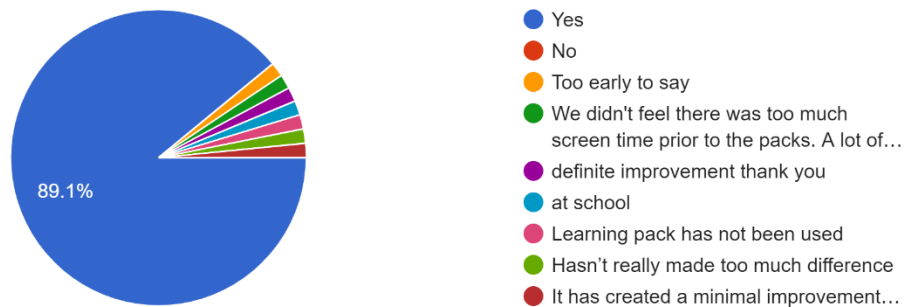

Pupils have recently been issued with Learning Packs to allow for more activities to take place without requiring screen time. Has this improved the home learning experience for your child?

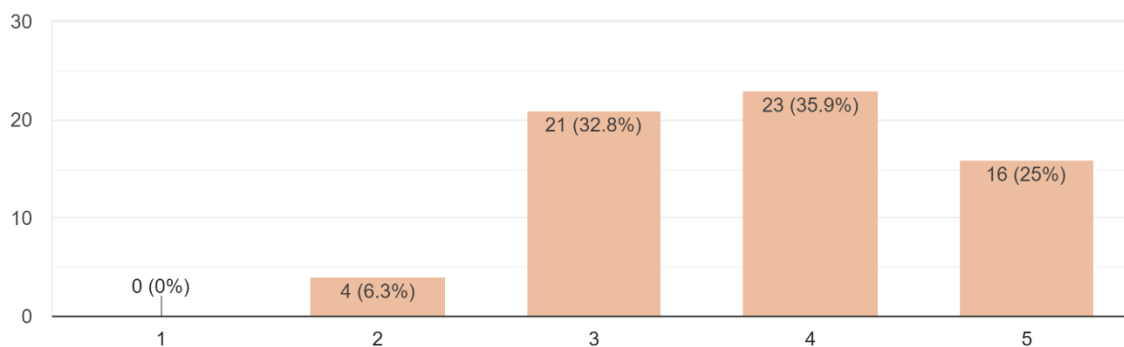

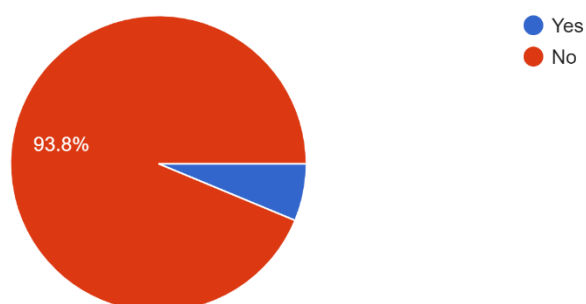
How well do you feel your child (children) has engaged with home learning?

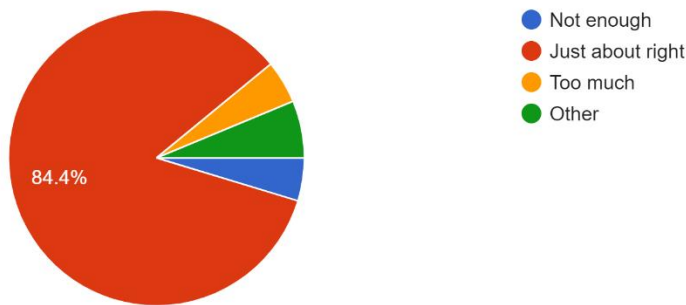
